THIRD STANDING ORDER CONCERNING ORAL ARGUMENT

On March 13, 2020, in response to the safety concerns posed by COVID-19, this court issued a standing order suspending in-person oral argument. Under this court’s March 13 order, counsel will deliver oral argument remotely through video conference, telephone conference, or other electronic means. On March 27, 2020, this court issued a second standing order concerning remote oral argument that provided, among other adopted procedures, “[a]t argument, each side will be allowed up to five minutes to give an uninterrupted opening argument.” For future oral argument, and until further order of this court, this time allotment is reduced to two minutes. Each side will be allowed up to two minutes to give an uninterrupted opening argument.
