Dear Mr. Navarrete:

The Court has scheduled this case for oral argument on June 6, 2017. Under California Rule of Court, rule 8.254, respondent submits *People v. Mickel* (2016) 2 Cal.5th 181, 205-210 (*Mickel*) as supplemental authority in this matter. *Mickel* is relevant to appellant's claims that: (1) the trial court failed to adequately inquire into his mental competence when evaluating his request to represent himself (AOB 23-50); (2) his presentation of no defense was tantamount to a guilty plea (AOB 68-87); and (3) the right to self-representation recognized in *Faretta v. California* (1975) 422 U.S. 806 does not extend to the guilt or penalty phases in a capital trial (Supplemental AOB 1-16).
