

Dear Mr. Navarrete:

On June 30, 2021, this Court granted review from an unpublished decision in the above-captioned case, in which the Court of Appeal affirmed the trial court's denial of McWilliams's motion to suppress. Appellant's opening brief is presently due on October 4, 2021. Respondent writes to inform the Court that—following further internal consideration and deliberation—respondent intends to take the position that the judgment of the Court of Appeal should not be affirmed. Specifically, respondent intends to argue that the officer's post-detention discovery of McWilliams's parole status did not sufficiently attenuate the taint from the officer's unlawful detention of McWilliams to render lawful the subsequent search of McWilliams and his vehicle.
