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

RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE

In his Opening Brief, in Ground VIII, Henderson claims his Sixth Amendment Confrontation Clause rights were violated when a non-performing pathologist testified instead of the pathologist who performed the autopsy on the decedent, Reginald Baker. The autopsy report was not admitted into evidence at trial. To the extent the report will



assist the Court in resolving Henderson's claim, Respondent requests the Court to take judicial notice of the autopsy report of Reginald Baker. (See *People v. Dungo* (2012) 55 Cal.4th 608, 615, citing *People v. Castillo* (2010) 49 Cal.4th 145, 157 [a court may take judicial notice of a public record when it does not consider the record for the truth of matters stated therein]; *Dixon v. Superior Court* (2009) 170 Cal.App.4th 1271, 1278 [an autopsy report is a public record].) Pursuant to this authority, Respondent requests that this Court take judicial notice of a true and correct copy of the autopsy report, which is attached as Exhibit A.

 - A. Atherosclerosis, coronary arteries with 75% occlusion of the left anterior descending, 90% occlusion of the circumflex and 99% occlusion of the right coronary artery
 - Status post coronary artery bypass grafts to left anterior descending, left obtuse marginal, circumflex, and right coronary artery (remote)
 - a. Total occlusion of grafts to left anterior descending, left obtuse marginal and circumflex coronary arteries
 - b. Adhesive pericarditis
 - 2. Cardiomegaly (525 gm)
 - 3. Left ventricular hypertrophy, heart (2.2 cm)

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION:

The body is that of a well-developed, well-nourished, elderly white many which appears to be about the stated age of 71 years old, weighing 230 pounds and measuring 69 inches in height. There is a 60 cm well-healed scar extending from the suprasternal notch of the chest to the public symphysis of the abdomen. Purple cyanosis is noted from the tops of the shoulders to the top of the head. There is a 3 x 4 cm healing yellow contusion over the right anterior chest. There are severally scars over the left lower extremity ranging in size from 8 to 12 cm. There is a 2 x 3 cm red-brown abrasion over the left shin. There is an incised wound to the anterior neck which will be separately described. The hair is gray. The head is not remarkable. The eyes and ears show no abnormality. The nose and mouth are normal. The neck is normal except for the incised wound which will be separately described. The chest shows no abnormality except for the previously described scars and healing contusions. The extremities show no significant injury. There are no other significant bruises or abrasions over the body.

DESCRIPTION OF INCISED WOUND:

There is a 4 inch transversely oriented incised wound over the mide anterior neck. The wound is centered and shows a jagged inferior margin with asymmetrical teeth marks on the inferior aspect. A blood-soaked cloth is present around the neck circumferentially. There is a 1/8 inch spared area on the right side of the neck on the lateral aspect of the incised wound, and then there is an additional 1/2 inch incised wound on the right side. The large incised wound is 10 inches down from the top of the head and is approximately 1/3 inch deep. The wound is in through the skin, full thickness, into the subcutaneous tissue. No major vessels or underlying structures, however, are injured.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION:

NOTE: All of the organ systems are within normal limits unless otherwise specified.

ORGAN WEIGHTS: See autopsy check list.

The heart is moderately enlarged and weighs 525 grams. Severe fibrous pericarditis is evident with extensive adhesions between the pericardial sac and epicardial surface of the heart. The left ventricle is hypertrophied and measures 2.2 cm in thickness. Transmural fibrosis of the left ventricle is evident with thinning to 0.8 cm of the posterior and posteroseptal left ventricle.

The coronary arteries show a right predominance and the LAD is 75% occluded, the circumflex 90% and RCA 99% with 75% occlusion of the left obtuse marginal branch. Coronary artery bypass grafts to the left

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anterior descending, left obtuse marginal, circumflex and right coronary arteries are present and intact. The left obtuse marginal and grafts to the left anterior descending are 100% occluded. The graft to the circumflex artery is 100% occluded with thrombus. The graft to the right coronary artery is patent.

Meticulous examination of the neck reveals intact underlying neck structures without severe injury.

The kidneys show fine and coarse granularity.

TOXICOLOGY: Bile and spleen tissue are submitted for routine toxicology.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Photographs are taken during the autopsy.

WITNESSES: Detective Wolford and I.D. tech Aguilar from the Cathedral City Police Department witnessed the autopsy. Deputy district attorneys Cauley and Carter witnessed the autopsy. Coroner's deputy Sandoval and I.D. Villanueva witnessed the autopsy.


OPINION: On the basis of the autopsy findings, it is evident that this 71-year-old man suffered from severe atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease which resulted in a sudden suspected cardiac arrhythmia which resulted in his demise. In addition, a contributing factor was the incised wound to his neck.
