I have been advised that counsel for appellant intends to focus on claim number two, regarding the admission of appellant's confession; claim number four, regarding the presentation of evidence and theories regarding volitional impairment that was allegedly inconsistent with those presented by the People in civil commitment cases; claim number five, regarding alleged prosecutorial misconduct when the prosecutor failed to correct false or misleading expert testimony; claim number six, regarding the exclusion of all evidence relating to Sexually Violent Predator proceedings; claim number seven, regarding the denial of cross-examination caused by the exclusion of such evidence; claim number eight, regarding alleged cruel and unusual punishment for defendants whose moral culpability is allegedly reduced by mental disorders which reduce their volitional control; and claim number nine, the alleged inability of the jury to consider the impairment of control due to mental disease or defect by virtue of the failure to properly instruct the jury in light of the People's expert testimony. In addition, I will be prepared to address any issue of interest to the Court.
