On June 2, 2021, Golden State Water Company (Petitioner) commenced Case No. S269099 by filing a petition for writ of review (writ petition) challenging Decision (D.) 20-08-047, issued by Respondent California Public Utilities Commission (Commission). At that time, Petitioner's and four other parties' applications for rehearing of D.20-08-047 were pending before the Commission.

On June 10, 2021, the Commission asked the Court to hold the writ petition in abeyance until the Commission had acted on the rehearing applications and to grant the Commission an extension of time to file its answer. In a June 15, 2021 Ruling, the Court granted the request and directed the parties to notify the Court when the Commission issued its decision resolving Petitioner's application for rehearing of D.20-08-047. This letter is written to inform the Court that on September 27, 2021, the Commission issued D.21-09-047, in which it modifies D.20-08-047 and denies Petitioner's application for rehearing of D.20-08-047. The Commission has attached a copy of D.21-09-047 to this filing.
