Brown et al.* (2017) 3 Cal.5th 808, 862, reh. den. Oct. 25, 2017.) Under section 1509, subdivision (g) of the Penal Code, the court exercises its authority to retain this petition and decide it.

The petition for writ of habeas corpus is denied.

All claims are denied on the merits.

Claims 1 (to the extent petitioner claims prosecutorial misconduct involving expert Brian Wraxall, questioning Norman Leung about threats, and making “a natural born killer” argument) and 6 (juror misconduct involving Juror N.N.) are procedurally barred to the extent they could have been, but were not, raised on appeal. (*In re Dixon* (1953) 41 Cal.2d 756, 759; see also *In re Reno* (2012) 55 Cal.4th 428, 443, 490-496.)

Claim 1 (to the extent petitioner claims prosecutorial misconduct during the guilt and penalty phases in questioning witnesses about petitioner’s alleged belief in Satanism and listening to heavy metal music) is procedurally barred to the extent it was raised and rejected on appeal. (*In re Waltreus* (1965) 62 Cal.2d 218, 225; see also *In re Reno, supra*, 55 Cal.4th at pp. 476-490.)

Claims 5 and 7 (except to the extent they allege ineffective assistance of counsel) are procedurally barred under *In re Seaton* (2004) 34 Cal.4th 193, 199, because petitioner failed to preserve the

claims at trial. (See also *In re Reno, supra*, 55 Cal.4th at pp. 443, 476-478.)

Liu, J., is of the opinion that an order to show cause should be granted, returnable in the superior court, limited to Claim 6.
