(*In re Dixon* (1953) 41 Cal.2d 756, 759; see also *In re Reno* (2012) 55 Cal.4th 428, 443, 490-496.) Claim 4 (to the extent it alleges the prosecutor committed misconduct involving alleged inducements or benefits for DeSoto's testimony and DeSoto's alleged perjured testimony) is procedurally barred to the extent it was raised and rejected on appeal. (*In re Waltreus* (1965) 62 Cal.2d 218, 225; see also *In re Reno, supra*, 55 Cal.4th at pp. 476-490.)

Claim 12 is procedurally barred under *In re Seaton* (2004) 34 Cal.4th 193, 201, because Curl failed to preserve the claim at trial. (See also *In re Reno* (2012) 55 Cal.4th 428, 443, 476-478.)
