The Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is ordered to show cause in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, when the matter is placed on calendar, why the relief prayed for should not be granted on the grounds that, as alleged in Claim 10, a juror committed prejudicial misconduct by: (1) viewing media coverage about petitioner's trial; and (2) not disclosing to the trial court any viewing of media coverage about petitioner's trial. The return is to be filed on or before July 16, 2021.

The court will review the proposed redactions and then make the findings required by California Rules of Court, rules 2.550(d) and (e) and 8.46(d)(6), if and as appropriate. Insofar as judicial direction may be required prior to the disclosure of probation reports, records containing summary criminal history information, and material drawn from the applicant's prison case records file, this order hereby provides such direction. (See Pen. Code, §§ 1203.05, subd. (c), 11105, subd. (h); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 15, § 3370, subd. (e).) The Governor may seek leave to file portions of these reports and records under seal to the extent they qualify for such filing under the standards set forth in Administrative Order 2021-05-26 and the Rules of Court.
