**S272435****CAMBRIDGE ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that CARL MICHAEL CAMBRIDGE (Respondent), State Bar Number 86047, is suspended from the practice of law in California for three years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and Respondent is placed on probation for three years subject to the following conditions:

1. Respondent is suspended from the practice of law for a minimum of the first two years of probation, and Respondent will remain suspended until providing proof to the State Bar Court of rehabilitation, fitness to practice and present learning and ability in the general law. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, std. 1.2(c)(1).)
2. Respondent must also comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Decision filed on November 10, 2021.
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if Respondent has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied, and that suspension will be terminated.

Respondent must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension. Respondent must also maintain the records of compliance as required by the conditions of probation.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment, and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.

**S272436****CALKINS ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that MARY LYNNE CALKINS (Respondent), State Bar Number 212171, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and Respondent is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. Respondent must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 17, 2021; and

2. At the expiration of the period of probation, if Respondent has complied with the terms of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied, and that suspension will be terminated.

Respondent must provide to the State Bar's Office of Probation proof of taking and passing the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination as recommended by the Hearing Department in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 17, 2021. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment, and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law. One-half of the costs must be paid with Respondent's annual fees for each of the years 2023 and 2024. If Respondent fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified in writing by the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

**S272438****GERAGHTY ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that THOMAS SCOTT GERAGHTY (Respondent), State Bar Number 230271, is disbarred from the practice of law and that Respondent's name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

Respondent must make restitution to the following payees or such other recipient as may be designated by the Office of Probation or the State Bar Court (or reimburse the Client Security Fund, to the extent of any payment from the Fund to such payees, in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6140.5). Reimbursement to the Fund is enforceable as a money judgment and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law:

- (8) Jenny Conley in the amount of \$1,301.49 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 19, 2016;
- (9) Beryl Fisher in the amount of \$5,275 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 27,

- (10) Fatima Harris in the amount of \$2,530 plus 10 percent interest per year from March 2, 2017;
  - (11) Salam Kneifati in the amount of \$1,128 plus 10 percent interest per year from December 16, 2016;
  - (12) Youland Malekpatcheviri in the amount of \$2,682.28 plus 10 percent interest per year from April 18, 2017;
  - (13) Carlota Mata in the amount of \$2,234.64 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 29, 2016;
  - (14) Robert Mize in the amount of \$5,660 plus 10 percent interest per year from December 11, 2017;
  - (15) Catalina Oney in the amount of \$2,296.40 plus 10 percent interest per year from October 20, 2016;
  - (16) Marty Robinson in the amount of \$9,250 plus 10 percent interest per year from December 16, 2016;
  - (17) Monica Rodriguez in the amount of \$168.97 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 29, 2016;
  - (18) Narith Ry in the amount of \$3,008.20 plus 10 percent interest per year from October 31, 2018;
  - (19) David Sanchez in the amount of \$342.25 plus 10 percent interest per year from April 8, 2016;
  - (20) John Spear in the amount of \$3,837.08 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 23, 2017;
  - (21) Ryan Needem in the amount of \$19,534.50 plus 10 percent interest per year from December 23, 2015;
  - (22) Anthony Timmons in the amount of \$9,171.16 plus 10 percent interest per year from October 4, 2016;

Respondent must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Respondent must pay monetary sanctions to the State Bar of California Client Security Fund in the amount of \$2,000 in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.13 and rule 5.137 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar. Monetary sanctions are enforceable as a money judgment and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment, and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.

**S272667****SCHNIEDERS ON  
DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that RICHARD JAMES SCHNIEDERS (Respondent), State Bar Number 156649, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that Respondent's name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

Respondent must comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Respondent must pay monetary sanctions to the State Bar of California Client Security Fund in the amount of \$5,000 in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.13 and rule 5.137 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar. Monetary sanctions are enforceable as a money judgment and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment, and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.

**S272668****VARGAS ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that GEORGE VINCENT VARGAS (Respondent), State Bar Number 234005, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and Respondent is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. Respondent is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. Respondent must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Decision filed on October 29, 2021; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if Respondent has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied, and that suspension will be terminated.

Respondent must pay monetary sanctions to the State Bar of California Client Security Fund in the amount of \$1,750 in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.13 and rule 5.137 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar. Monetary sanctions are enforceable as a money judgment and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment, and may be collected by the State Bar through any means permitted by law.
