The court will review the proposed redactions and then make the findings required by California Rules of Court, rules 2.550(d) and (e) and 8.46(d)(6), if and as appropriate. Insofar as judicial direction may be required prior to the disclosure of probation reports, records containing summary criminal history information, and material drawn from the applicant's prison case records file, this order hereby provides such direction. (See Pen. Code, §§ 1203.05, subd. (c), 11105, subd. (h); Cal. Code

Regs., tit. 15, § 3370, subd. (e).) The Governor may seek leave to file portions of these reports and records under seal to the extent they qualify for such filing under the standards set forth in Administrative Order 2021-05-26 and the Rules of Court.

The Governor shall provide a copy of this order to the clemency applicant in this matter not less than ten days prior to resubmitting the record to the court.

The First Amendment Coalition's request for sanctions is denied.
