**ORDER MODIFYING OPINION & DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING**

**THE COURT:**

The majority opinion in this matter, filed on November 10, 2025, and appearing at 18 Cal.5th 970, is modified as follows:

1. The second to last sentence of the first full paragraph on page 985, which begins, “In the wake of those decisions . . . ,” is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Prior to the issuance of those decisions, the City of Los Angeles (the City) had entered into a consent decree with the federal government that effectively barred it from requiring complainants to sign the type of advisory described in section 148.6(a)(2).

2. The first sentence of the second full paragraph on page 991, which begins, “Following those federal decisions . . . ,” is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Before those cases were decided, the City had entered into a consent decree with the federal government that prevented the City from enforcing the advisory requirement set forth in section 148.6(a)(2).

This modification does not affect the judgment.

The petition for writ of habeas corpus has been read and considered. Petitioner contends, among other claims, that he is entitled to relief under the Racial Justice Act of 2020 (Pen. Code, § 745). In this respect, petitioner alleges that the judge, an attorney in the case, a law enforcement officer involved in the case, an expert witness, or juror exhibited bias or animus towards the defendant because of defendant's race, ethnicity, or national origin.

Petitioner "has not established a prima facie showing" under the Racial Justice Act. (Pen. Code, § 1473, subd. (e)(7)(A).) Petitioner fails to allege particularized facts that support his claims based on alleged exhibitions of racial bias or animus. (*Id.*, § 745, subd. (a)(1); cf. *In re Swain* (1949) 34 Cal.2d 300, 304 [a petition for writ of habeas corpus must allege sufficient facts with particularity].) Nor does petitioner describe or attach supporting documentary evidence concerning these claims. (Cf. *People v. Duvall* (1995) 9 Cal.4th 464, 474 [a petition for writ of habeas corpus must include copies of reasonably available documentary evidence].)
