Concurring Statement by Justice Groban

In 2007, petitioner Nancy Mendoza participated in two separate kidnapping crimes. In each case, she lured a victim to a secluded location where Los Palillos gang members detained and abused

the victim and held him captive for ransom for an extended length of time. One victim was eventually released after having paid a ransom and the other victim was rescued in a police raid. For her crimes, Mendoza was sentenced to life without the possibility for parole. The legal issues in this case have been thoroughly litigated in over a decade of post-conviction proceedings and I agree with the court's conclusion to deny the petition for writ of habeas corpus. Mendoza simply has not shown that counsel rendered prejudicial ineffective assistance of counsel at sentencing. However, there are several facts that raise significant questions as to whether Mendoza's sentence of life without the possibility of parole is a just result. First, Mendoza was 18 years and 6 months of age at the time of the first kidnapping and 18 years and 11 months of age at the time of the second. If Mendoza had been a few months younger at the time of her offenses, she would not be eligible for her life without the possibility of parole sentence. (See *Miller v. Alabama* (2012) 567 U.S. 460; Pen. Code, § 3051, subd. (b)(1)-(4).)

Second, at the time of both kidnappings, she had no criminal record, was employed, and was attending school. She was also in a romantic relationship with Juan Estrada-Gonzalez, who was a senior Los Palillos gang member and was an accomplice in each of the kidnappings. Mendoza claims that she was manipulated and influenced by the older Estrada-Gonzalez, who was around 27 years old at the time of the events in question.

Third, at an evidentiary hearing below, a defense expert witness testified that the prosecution originally offered Mendoza a plea of 15 years if she agreed to testify against her boyfriend Estrada-Gonzalez, but she refused to testify against him. The expert witness further testified that, after Mendoza was convicted of the charges, the prosecution offered her "either 25- or 30-year-to-life sentence in order to testify," and she again declined. Two of her other accomplices, on the other hand, agreed to testify in exchange for more lenient determinate sentences of 27 years and 28 years respectively. Thus, Mendoza, in an apparent effort to protect her boyfriend, is currently condemned to life without parole, while two of her accomplices are not.

Perhaps cognizant of the seeming inequity of this result, the District Attorney has highlighted, in briefing below, some of the ways Mendoza could attempt to obtain resentencing in the future, including applying for a District Attorney initiated resentencing (Pen. Code, § 1172.1, subd. (a)(1)), a Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation initiated resentencing (Pen. Code, § 1172.1, subd. (a)(1), or a commutation (Cal. Const., art. V, § 8; Pen. Code, § 4800 et seq.). I write separately to highlight that our denial of the petition for writ of habeas corpus here does not necessarily preclude Mendoza from obtaining such relief at some point in the future, including:

- (1) a potential referral for recall and resentencing by the Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, the Board of Parole Hearings, or the District Attorney (see Pen. Code, § 1172.1, subd. (a)(3) ["The resentencing court may, in the interest of justice and regardless of whether the original sentence was imposed after a trial or plea agreement," reduce or vacate the sentence]; *id.*, subd. (a)(5) ["The court shall consider . . . if the defendant was a victim of intimate partner violence or human trafficking prior to or at the time of the commission of the offense, or if the defendant is a youth or was a youth as defined under subdivision (b) of Section 1016.7 at the time of the commission of the offense, and whether those circumstances were a contributing factor in the commission of the offense"])). (1) This option may prove particularly relevant to the District Attorney here, who has already raised the possibility of resentencing in briefing below, and who had previously offered Mendoza a far more favorable plea deal than the sentence she ultimately

received;

Petitioner’s additional motions requesting extension of the deadline to file a petition for review in this court challenging the Hearing Department’s disbarment recommendation, which were filed on March 25, 2024, April 8, 2024, and April 9, 2024, are denied as moot.
