Extension of time granted

Upon application of Senior Deputy State Public Defender Andrea Asaro, an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's supplemental opening brief is granted to July 16, 2024. After that date, only one further extension totaling about 60 additional days is contemplated. Within 30 days after any supplemental opening brief has been filed pursuant to this order, the People may serve and file a supplemental answering brief, not to exceed 50 pages in length. Appellant may thereafter serve and file a reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length, within 20 days after the People have filed their supplemental answering brief.
