**S178239****PEOPLE v. HARRIS (KAI)**

Extension of time granted

Based upon Supervising Deputy Attorney General Dana Muhammad Ali's representation that the supplemental respondent's brief is anticipated to be filed by October 11, 2023, an extension of time in which to serve and file that brief is granted to August 28, 2023. After that date, only one further extension totaling about 44 additional days is contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing date. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631(d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)

Extension of time granted
