The court is in receipt of petitioner's application to file the unredacted petition for review and exhibits under seal, filed May 26, 2026. The court has reviewed the application and concludes that exhibits B, E, F, G, and H in the Appendices of Exhibits should be sealed for purposes of proceedings before this court. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.46(b).) The court denies the application to seal as to the remainder of the exhibits, which are publicly filed in the State Bar Court, for failure to provide facts sufficient to justify sealing. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rules 2.550, 2.551, 8.46, and 8.47.) The court also denies the application to seal the unredacted petition for review. Within 10 days of the issuance of this order, petitioner may file a version of the petition for review redacting only information that is sealable pursuant to California Rules of Court, rules 8.46 and 8.47, and a version of the Appendices of Exhibits redacting only exhibits B, E, F, G, and H, upon receipt of which the clerk shall file the unredacted petition for review and exhibits under seal. Alternatively, petitioner may notify the court that the unredacted petition for review (lodged conditionally under seal on May 26, 2026) should be filed unsealed as part of the public record. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rules 8.46(d)(7), 8.47(c)(2)(D).)
