**S065877****PEOPLE v. LOPEZ (BOBBY)  
& TRUJEQUE (JAMES)**

Extension of time granted

On application of appellant Bobby Lopez, it is ordered that the time to serve and file appellant's opening brief is extended to September 3, 2024.

**S150524****PEOPLE v. ARGUETA  
(CARLOS MARVIN)**

Extension of time granted

Upon application of Supervising Deputy State Public Defender William Whaley, an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's supplemental opening brief is granted to September 6, 2024. After that date, no further extensions are contemplated. Within 30 days after any supplemental opening brief has been filed pursuant to this order, the People may serve and file a supplemental answering brief, not to exceed 50 pages in length. Appellant may thereafter serve and file a reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length, within 20 days after the People have filed their supplemental answering brief.

**S165894****PEOPLE v. PENUELAS  
(JESUS GUADALUPE  
VELAZQUEZ)**

Extension of time granted

Upon application of Senior Deputy State Public Defender Andrea Asaro, an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's supplemental opening brief is granted to September 16, 2024. After that date, no further extensions are contemplated. Within 30 days after any supplemental opening brief has been filed pursuant to this order, the People may serve and file a supplemental answering brief, not to exceed 50 pages in length. Appellant may thereafter serve and file a reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length, within 20 days after the People have filed their supplemental answering brief.

**S169689****PEOPLE v. EVANS (STEVE  
CARL)**

Extension of time granted

Upon application of counsel Cliff Gardner, an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's supplemental opening brief is granted to August 21, 2024. Within 30 days after any supplemental opening brief has been filed pursuant to this order, the People may serve and file a supplemental answering brief, not to exceed 50 pages in length. Appellant may thereafter serve and file a reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length, within 20 days after the People have filed their supplemental answering brief.

**S173784****PEOPLE v. OYLER  
(RAYMOND LEE)**

Extension of time granted

Upon application of counsel Michael Clough, an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's supplemental opening brief is granted to August 7, 2024. After that date, no further extensions will be granted. Within 30 days after any supplemental opening brief has been filed pursuant to this order, the People may serve and file a supplemental answering brief, not to exceed 50 pages in length. Appellant may thereafter serve and file a reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length, within 20 days after the People have filed their supplemental answering brief.

**S222619****PEOPLE v. SYKES (KESAUN  
KEDRON)**

Extension of time granted

The application of appellant for relief from default for the failure to timely file appellant's application for extension of time is granted.

Based upon counsel David P. Lampkin's representation that the appellant's reply brief is anticipated to be filed by October 31, 2024, an extension of time in which to serve and file that brief is granted to September 3, 2024. After that date, only one further extension totaling about 58 additional days is contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing date. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631(d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)
