THE COURT:

The opinion in this matter, which was filed August 19, 2024, is modified as follows:

1. The third sentence of the paragraph on page 16, which states, “ ‘By contrast, other courts have applied “a hybrid substantial evidence/abuse of discretion standard, reviewing for substantial evidence whether there is reason to know a child is an Indian child, and for abuse of discretion a juvenile court’s finding that an agency exercised due diligence and conducted a ‘proper and adequate’ ICWA inquiry” ’ ” is modified to read:

“By contrast, other courts have used a hybrid standard, reviewing for substantial evidence whether there is reason to know a minor is an Indian child, and reviewing a finding of due diligence and proper inquiry for abuse of discretion.”

This modification does not affect the judgment.

Petitioners and the Attorney General are directed to serve and file briefs on or before October 28, 2024, addressing the following issues:

- (1) On what ground or grounds, if any, does each petitioner have standing to challenge the prosecution, imposition, and execution of all death sentences in this state?
- (2) Have petitioners alleged facts that, if proven true, would establish a violation of the California Constitution (art. I, §§ 7, 17) and entitle them to all or part of the relief they seek, including an order prohibiting all future capital prosecutions and the enforcement or execution of any death sentence previously imposed? How, if at all, does article I, section 27 of the California Constitution affect this determination? How, if at all, does the classification of this matter as an as-applied or a facial challenge affect this determination?
- (3) What parties are necessary to properly consider the requested relief and effectuate it, if warranted?

Any application to file an amicus curiae brief (see Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.520(f)) must be served and filed on or before November 12, 2024.

Petitioners and the Attorney General each may serve and file a reply brief on or before November 26, 2024.

Petitioners' "Motion to Seal Portions of Applications for Admission Pro Hac Vice," filed April 18, 2024, is granted. In ordering this sealing, this court makes the findings required by California Rules of Court, rules 2.550(d)-(e) and 8.46(e). 2. Respondent must also comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Decision filed on February 13, 2024.
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if Respondent has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated. Respondent must provide to the State Bar's Office of Probation proof of taking and passing the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination as recommended by the Hearing Department in its Decision filed on February 13, 2024. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Respondent must comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in (a) and (c) of that rule within 120 and 130 calendar days, respectively, after the date this order is filed.
