**S150524****PEOPLE v. ARGUETA  
(CARLOS MARVIN)**

Extension of time granted

Upon application of Deputy Attorney General Gabriel Bradley, an extension of time in which to serve and file respondent's second supplemental brief is granted to December 5, 2024. Within 20 days after any supplemental respondent's brief has been filed pursuant to this order, Appellant may thereafter serve and file a supplemental reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length.

**S172750****PEOPLE v. KENNEDY (JOHN  
FITZGERALD)**

Extension of time granted

Upon application of counsel Christian C. Buckley, an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's supplemental opening brief is granted to December 2, 2024. Within 30 days after any supplemental opening brief has been filed pursuant to this order, the People may serve and file a supplemental answering brief, not to exceed 50 pages in length. Appellant may thereafter serve and file a reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length, within 20 days after the People have filed their supplemental answering brief.

Extension of time granted

Upon application of Deputy Attorney General Colleen M. Tiedemann, an extension of time in which to serve and file respondent's supplemental answering brief is granted to October 28, 2024. Within 20 days after any supplemental answering brief has been filed pursuant to this order, Appellant may thereafter serve and file a supplemental reply, not to exceed 25 pages in length.

**S200016****PEOPLE v. TOPETE (MARCO ANTONIO)**

Extension of time granted

Based upon counsel, Deputy Attorney General Caely E. Fallini's representation that the respondent's brief is anticipated to be filed by December 16, 2024, an extension of time in which to serve and file that brief is granted to December 2, 2024. After that date, only one further extension totaling about 14 additional days is contemplated.

**S211045****PEOPLE v. PEREZ (CHRISTIAN)**

Extension of time granted

The application of appellant for relief from default for the failure to timely file appellant's application for extension of time is granted.

Based upon counsel Michael Lasher's representation that the supplemental appellant's reply brief is anticipated to be filed by January 30, 2025, an extension of time in which to serve and file that brief is granted to November 19, 2024. After that date, only two further extensions totaling about 72 additional days are contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing date. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631(d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)

The Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is ordered to show cause before the Riverside County Superior Court why petitioner is not entitled to appointment of counsel pursuant to Penal

Code section 1473, subdivision (e), in light of data provided by petitioner demonstrating racial disparities in charging special circumstance murder in Riverside County.
