Extension of time granted

Upon application of counsel Senior Deputy State Public Defender Jessica Oats', an extension of time in which to serve and file the appellant's opening brief is granted to December 12, 2022. The court anticipates that after that date, only five further extensions totaling about 303 additional days are contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing date. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631(d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)

After that date, only one further extension totaling about 37 additional days is contemplated.

Extension of time granted

Based on counsel Senior Deputy State Public Defender Andrea Asaro's representation that the appellant's opening brief is anticipated to be filed by October 10, 2023, an extension of time in which to serve and file that brief is granted to December 12, 2022. After that date, only five further extension totaling about 302 days are contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing dated. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631 (d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)
