## Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions During Week of July 21, 2025

**#25-256 *People v. Arceo*, S291447.** (G063574; nonpublished opinion; Orange County Superior Court; 97CF2677.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-257 *People v. Giuffra*, S291524.** (B337189; nonpublished opinion; Los Angeles County Superior Court; A465712.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-258 *People v. Green*, S291453.** (C101491; nonpublished opinion; Sacramento County Superior Court; 18FE006985.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal modified and affirmed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter.

**#25-259 *People v. Harvey*, S291468.** (G063797; nonpublished opinion; Orange County Superior Court; 10HF1993.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-260 *People v. Ivora*, S291451.** (G063638; nonpublished opinion; Orange County Superior Court; 18WF1307.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-261 *People v. Lamb*, S291112.** (E082846; nonpublished opinion; Riverside County Superior Court; RIF1700595.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal affirmed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter.

**#25-262 *People v. Lee*, S291459.** (G063673; nonpublished opinion; Orange County Superior Court; 98NF1887.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-263 *People v. Lopez*, S291446.** (G063435; nonpublished opinion; Orange County Superior Court; 96CF1469.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-264 *People v. Nguyen*, S291460.** (G063777; nonpublished opinion; Orange County Superior Court; 05ZF0092.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

**#25-265 *People v. Torres*, S291499.** (H051389; nonpublished opinion; Santa Clara County Superior Court; C1774786.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter and remanded for resentencing.

The court ordered briefing in *Arceo*, *Giuffra*, *Green*, *Harvey*, *Ivora*, *Lamb*, *Lee*, *Lopez*, *Nguyen*, and *Torres* deferred pending finality of the decision in *People v. Rhodius* (June 26, 2025, S283169) \_\_\_ Cal.5th \_\_\_.

**#25-266 *People v. Herrick*, S291347.** (C101104; nonpublished opinion; Shasta County Superior Court; 15F6010.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal modified and affirmed an order revoking probation in a criminal matter. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in *People v. Mitchell*, S277314 (#22-305), which presents the following issue: Does Senate Bill No. 567 (Stats. 2021, ch. 731), which limits a trial court's discretion to impose upper term sentences, apply retroactively to defendants sentenced pursuant to stipulated plea agreements?

**#25-267 *People v. Medina*, S291301.** (H051661; nonpublished opinion; Monterey County Superior Court; 23CR004036.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal affirmed a judgment of conviction of criminal offenses. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in *People v. Fletcher*, S281282 (#23-188), which presents the following issues: (1) Does Assembly Bill No. 333 amend the requirements for a true finding on a prior strike conviction (Pen. Code, §§ 667, subds. (b)–(i) & 1170.12, subds.

(a)–(d)) and a prior serious felony conviction (Pen. Code, § 667, subd. (a)), or is that determination made on “the date of that prior conviction”? (See Pen. Code, §§ 667, subd. (d)(1) & 1170.12, subd. (b)(1).) (2) Does Assembly Bill No. 333 (Stats. 2021, ch. 699), which modified the criminal street gang statute (Pen. Code, § 186.22), unconstitutionally amend Proposition 21 and Proposition 36, if applied to strike convictions and serious felony convictions?
