Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions During Week of October 4, 2021

The California Supreme Court has announced that no cases were accepted during the week of October 4, 2021.

STATUS

#19-172 *People v. Lopez*, S258175. The court directed the parties to file supplemental briefs addressing the significance, if any, of Senate Bill No. 775 (Stats. 2021, ch. 551) to the issues presented in this case.

The Supreme Court of California is the state's highest court and its decisions are binding on all other California state courts. The court's primary role is to decide matters of statewide importance and to maintain uniformity in the law throughout California by reviewing matters from the six districts of the California Courts of Appeal and the fifty-eight county superior courts (the trial courts). Among its other duties, the court also decides all capital appeals and related matters and reviews both attorney and judicial disciplinary matters.
