Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions During Week of December 19, 2022

[This news release is issued to inform the public and the press of cases that the Supreme Court has accepted and of their general subject matter. The statement of the issue or issues in each case set out below does not necessarily reflect the view of the court, or define the specific issues that will be addressed by the court.]

#22-313 *People v. Androshchuk*, **\$277282.** (C094802; nonpublished opinion; Sacramento County Superior Court; 07F07669.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal affirmed an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in *People v. Williams*, \$262229 (#20-189), which presents the following issue: Does Penal Code section 3051, subdivision (h), violate the equal protection clause of the Fourteenth Amendment by excluding young adults convicted and sentenced for serious sex crimes under the One Strike law (Pen. Code, § 667.61) from youth offender parole consideration, while young adults convicted of first degree murder are entitled to such consideration?

#22-314 *People v. Chiemwichitra*, **S276994.** (C096201; nonpublished opinion; Shasta County Superior Court; 19F4451.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal dismissed an appeal from an order denying a post-judgment motion in a criminal matter. The court ordered briefing deferred pending finality of the decision in *People v. Delgadillo* (Dec. 19, 2022; S266305) __ Cal.5th __.

Among its other duties, the court also decides all capital appeals and related matters and reviews both attorney and judicial disciplinary matters.
